Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term 3L are taking a trip back in history to Roman times. We will be exploring life in pre-Roman Britain; Rome and the Roman Empire; the Roman army; Roman York (Eboracum); the revolt of Boudicca; and the decline and fall of the Roman Empire. In our creative work we will be designing and making Roman purses; experimenting with mosaic drawings; and listening to and composing our own Roman style music.

The children will continue to go swimming on a Tuesday afternoon (starting next week 23/04/13) and will have Coach Lee on Wednesday mornings.
