Fiction: Stories - penguin and Christmas themed.
Non fiction: Non-chronological reports: Headings, sub-headings, information, technical vocab; Sequencing events from Gunpowder Plot.
Drama and Speaking and Listening: Role play area - Antarctic; Christmas play

Changes beyond living memory - Christmas in the past.

Maths

Number - number and place value.
Number - addition, subtraction, multiplication, division. Fractions.
Statistics - pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams, bar charts, tables.
Measurement - length, weight, capacity, recap time and money.

Games with Complete Sport - developing balance, agility and co-ordination; developing simple tactics for attacking and defending, evaluating and improving own performances.
Dance - developing balance, agility and co-ordination.

Geography

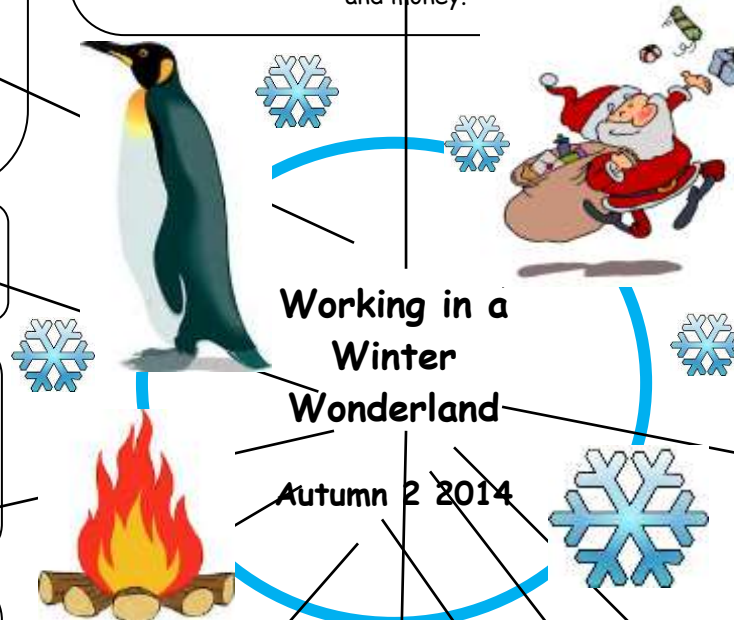
Locational knowledge - 7 continents, 5 oceans, UK countries, capitals.
