Help at Home

- The children still need to be reading at home, even if it is just a page a night this is fine, but it keeps them practising every night.
- Maths is a big focus in the Unit. By the end of Reception, children need to know their numbers to 20 – this is counting to 20 but also recognising their numbers.
- For year 1's children could practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

A few reminders.

Outdoor provision is available every day, please could you make sure that the children have all the outdoor wear to keep them warm please, **including sensible footwear.**

As always, please send your child with spare changes of clothes as we have to make more and more phone calls home and wet clothes leave your child feeling very uncomfortable.
