

Literacy

Fiction: Stories relating to Florence
Non fiction: Information texts, facts about Florence, comparing past and present. Recounts.
Drama and Speaking and Listening: Role play area - Hospital
Reading: Non-fiction: facts about Florence Nightingale.
Grammar - adverbs, openers, adjectives, connectives, full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, question marks.

Music

Developing listening and appraising skills through the study of Victorian music halls and songs of that time.

ICT

Creating a powerpoint presentation about Florence Nightingale - changing font, inserting clip art, etc. and presenting to peers.

Science

Working scientifically.
Light - linked with Florence's lamp and different forms of light sources. Looking at how shadows are formed and creating shadow puppet shows of Florence's life.

MFL (French)

Recap name, age, numbers 0-10, greetings.
Colours, instructions.

History

Florence Nightingale e.g. enquiry, facts about her, sequencing on a timeline, comparing nursing past and present, looking at sources of information and artefacts. Visit to Thackray Medical Museum.

Maths

Number - number and place value.
Number - addition, subtraction, multiplication, division - vocabulary, inverse, missing number problems.
Shape - 2D and 3D, features, symmetry, angles.

PE

Games with Complete Sport - developing balance, agility and co-ordination; developing simple tactics for attacking and defending, evaluating and improving own performances.
Gymnastics - balance, agility and co-ordination.

Going for Goals

Knowing myself, setting a realistic goal, planning to reach a goal, persistence, making choices, reflecting.

Art

Portraits of Florence Nightingale.
History themed Art activities e.g. dress a nurse, comparing hospitals past and present.

Geography

Locational knowledge - 7 continents, 5 oceans, Italy, UK countries, capitals.
Place - similarities and differences of Italy compared with England.
Human and physical - features.
Geographical fieldwork - maps, atlases, globes.

Looking at sign and symbols in different religions.
