Geography

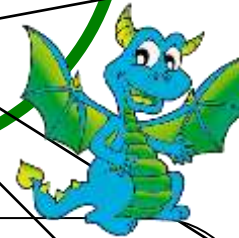
Where are dragons in the world? (Komodo dragons)
